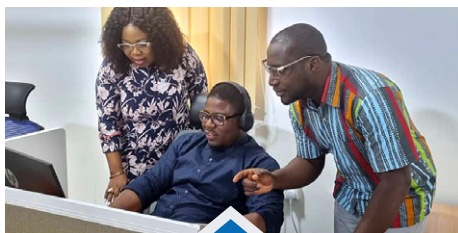

## African Transformation Report (ATR)

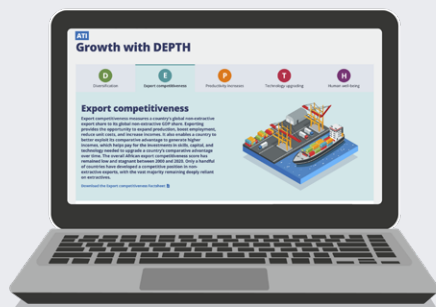
Grounded in original analysis but drawing on best practices from across Africa and the world, each ATR explores in-depth challenges to transformation — and offers specific solutions.
